

Pronouns Reflexive Pronouns in Use

A Pronoun replaces a noun. The pronoun is used when we don't know a more specific name or word for the noun. A reflexive pronoun is used when the subject and object of the sentence are the same.

Example: I dressed **myself** this morning. He ate breakfast all by **himself**.
